Our main texts this half term will be, My Best Friend the Suffragette by Sally Morgan and All about Winston Churchill by C.A. Crane.

We will be learning to:

- Write letters and Newspaper reports
- Write a wide range of fully demarcated sentences.
- Use paragraphs in our writing
- Use organisational devices when writing non narrative pieces, e.g., headings and sub-headings
- Organise our writing into paragraphs.
- Write speech sentences using inverted commas and a variety of rich vocabulary
- Use prepositions and adverbs to express time and place
- Evaluate and edit our written work



Maths

This term we will be learning to:

- Find 10 or 100 more or less than any given number
- Consistently read and write numbers beyond 100 in numerals and words
- Recall facts from the 2, 5, and 10 times tables and some facts from the 3 and 4 times tables.
- Recognise the place value of hundreds, tens and ones
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and words
- Add up to 3 digits, not crossing the barrier
- Subtract up to three digits not using exchange (borrowing)
