International Week

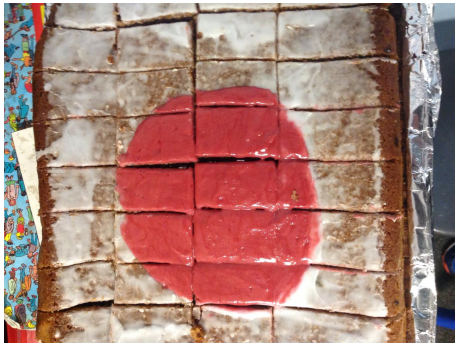
Once again, our International Week has been a huge success, with the children learning about different countries and cultures around the world. Here are a few photos capturing a snapshot of the week.
