and they even got to sit in the dugout.



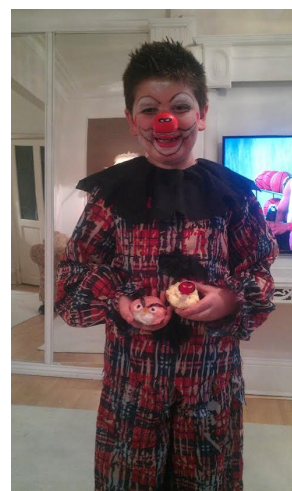
Comic Relief 2015
