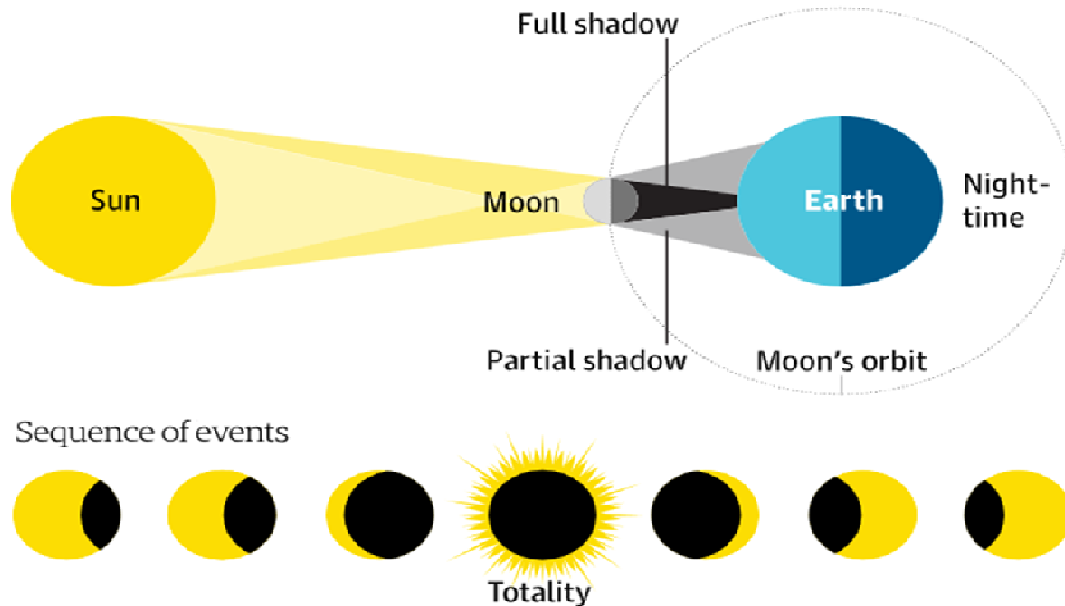

How an eclipse is formed

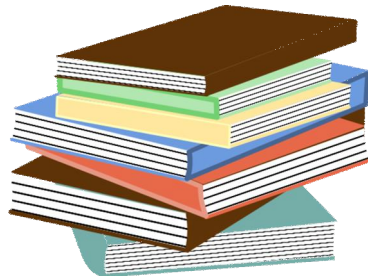
