School Nurse



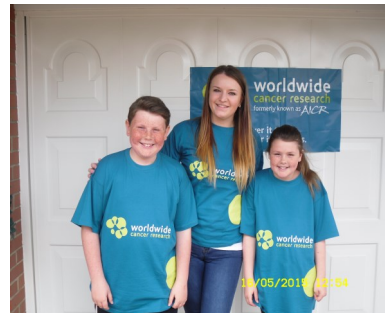
As the school nurse will be working on the flu vaccination programme again this year, she will not be able to offer drop in sessions this term.

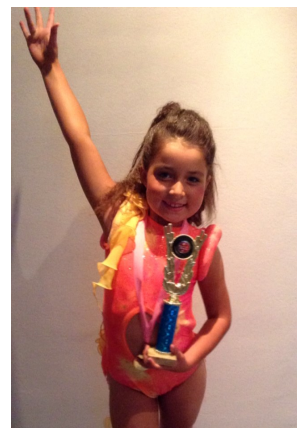
