COVID Update

We currently have 5 classes out in self isolation. The two Reception classes (due back 14th), Miss Stratford's Y1 class (due back 14th) and the Year 2 classes. We have had a number of both adults and children getting tested this week, thankfully most test results have been negative. As soon as we are made aware of a positive result, we will contact you directly to inform you, if this affects your child. Unfortunately, we do not always receive the results prior to the school day, so this may happen when your child is already in class.

When we send children home to self isolate, we do so following the advice of Public Health. We appreciate that this is a challenging time and appreciate your support on this.

Should we be made aware of a test taken during the weekend, Mrs Todd will still inform you when the test result returns, if positive, whenever that is.
