

<p>Wednesday 6th Jan- Friday 8th Jan</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Home Learning Winter</p> <p>There are lots of lovely Winter themed cartoons and programmes on cbeebies iplayer- search winter. Chat about the signs of Winter you can see when watching them.</p>
<p>Speaking and Listening</p>	<p>Talk about Winter. What changes do you see in the winter? What is the weather like? What kind of things can you do for fun in the winter? What do you need to wear?</p>
<p>Mark making</p>	<p>Draw some pictures of things that you see/do in winter. Try to write words/initial sounds to go with your pictures. Grown up could model writing a short sentence e.g. I can see a tree. I can see a snowman. (Don't worry if your child isn't ready for this yet and also don't worry about the spellings of the words- the important thing is that your child is hearing the sounds in the words)</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> Practise all of the sounds we have done so far. If you have a purple sound book at home please practise the sounds frequently.</p> <p>Adult says a sound, child has to write it down. Adult says a sound, child has to write a word beginning with that sound. Adult writes a sound and child says what it is. Art and craft	Winter colour collage- Find things around the house that are winter colours (blue, silver, white, purple etc.) and cut out and make a collage. You can also colour using pens and pencils in winter colours.
Shape, space and measure	Measuring- Choose 3-5 toys from the house and put them in order of height. Try to record it on a piece of paper. Shapes- Make a snowman using different shapes of paper. Talk about the shapes you have used and some of their properties.
