


<p style="text-align: center;">The Bumblebear</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Home Learning</u></p> <p>Video on class Dojo of Miss Golightly reading the story.</p> <p>Story is also on youtube: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o6ZaSM6sNGw</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Speaking and Listening</p>	<p>Watch and listen to the story on class dojo as many times as you like!</p> <p>Listen to what happens in the beginning, middle and end and try to retell the story.</p> <p>Look at the front cover of the book and make predictions about what you think might happen.</p> <p>Alliteration- buzzy bee, big bear, mad monkey, cute cat</p> <p>Think of some of your own examples and share them with us. Peppa Pig characters are great for alliteration examples!</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Mark making</p>	<p>Draw/write your own version of the story.</p> <p>Practise writing your name and the letter sounds we've covered so far.</p> <p>Think about something you really love- draw a picture of it and try to write some words.</p> <p>Think about what you would like to dress up as- draw a picture and write labels.</p> <p>Who are your friends at school? Draw pictures of them and try to write their names. Try to write a short sentence about one of your friends. E.g she is the best.</p> <p><u>Write captions/sentences</u></p> <p>Depending upon your child's level, either encourage your child to write their own sentence or copy yours.</p> <p>I love... I love...(repetition) This is... This is... (repetition)</p>

	<p>If you're struggling to get your child to do the writing, ask them to tell you the sentence then you can write it and your child can draw a picture to match.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> Practise all of the sounds we have done so far (Keep referring to flash card video on dojo and there's a good flash card game on phonicsplay.) If you have a purple sound book at home please practise the sounds frequently.</p> <p>The children should be reading words and writing their own words using the sounds they know.</p> <p>j w x w y z zz qu ch sh ng th ai ee igh oa oo ur ar or ow air oi ear ure er</p> <p>Adult says a sound, child has to write it down. Adult says a sound, child has to write a word beginning with that sound. Adult writes a sound and child says what it is. Play I-spy. Practise blending Practise segmenting (use dojo videos to help)</p> <p>Words to practise reading and writing: and, to, the, no, go, I, he, she, we, me, be, was, my.</p> <p><u>A NEW PHONICS GAME/ACTIVITY WILL BE PUT ONTO CLASS DOJO MOST DAYS. Art and craft	<p>Make a paper plate bumble bee (don't worry if you don't have any plates, just use paper!)- Count how many black stripes and how many yellow stripes.</p> <p>Draw a map to find the hidden honey</p>

	Make a bee hotel using junk materials
Understanding the World	<p>What do you know about bees?</p> <p>Do some research about bees and how to make honey- use google search etc. Record your findings to show us.</p>
Shape, space and measure	<p>Time- look at the clocks in the book and talk about morning, afternoon, night etc.</p> <p>School day- draw pictures of the daily routine at school- morning, dinner time, afternoon etc.</p> <p>Grown up draw pictures of a typical day at home for child to put in order e.g. brush teeth, breakfast, get ready etc.</p> <p>Make a shape picture- talk about the shapes you are using</p>
Number	<p>One more/one less than-</p> <p>Draw and cut out bees, count out specific amounts and then find one more and one less- try to record</p> <p>Practical addition and subtraction using toys/objects at home</p>
Personal and Social	<p>Talk about emotions-</p> <p>What are you scared of? What makes you happy? Etc.</p>
