Mark making	Draw/write your own version of the story.
	Practise writing your name and the letter sounds we've covered so far.
	Think about something you really love- draw a picture of it and try to write some words.
	Think about what you would like to dress up as- draw a picture and write labels.
	Who are your friends at school? Draw pictures of them and try to write their names. Try to write a short sentence about one of your friends. E.g she is the best.
	<u>Write captions/sentences</u> Depending upon your child's level, either encourage your child to write their own sentence or copy yours.

	If you're struggling to get your child to do the writing, ask them to tell you the sentence then you can write it and your child can draw a picture to match.

	The children should be reading words and writing their own words using the sounds they know.
