Some subject topics relate more easily to others and can be taught in a cross-curricular manner. Most of the teaching and learning this term will occur through the topic 'Life after WWII in Britain'.

Reading - We ask that your child still reads regularly - at least 10 minutes each day using MyON

Spelling - Initial learning of spellings will take place in school, but practise will need to continue at home also. They can be found in Google Classroom

The children will receive Maths and English homework each week in Google Classroom. The children are given homework that is usually based on the learning of the week and believed by the teacher to be able to be completed independently.

Games will be every Thursday afternoon. Children are now asked to come into school in their games kit. They must have appropriate kit for the weather including a warm sweatshirt/hoody and waterproof coat.
