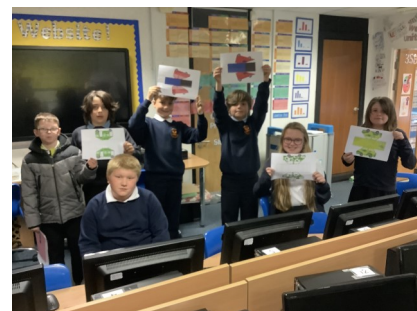
Please remember to keep your child at home until their test result has been returned.
