Air Ambulance Visit

On Tuesday, we had an ambulance and an Air Ambulance arrive on our school field. The member of staff who took ill, is now feeling better and being well looked after. Thanks to those of you who asked after her.

As the helicopter and pilot, Nigel, needed to wait on our school field until the medical team returned from the hospital, he kindly offered to speak to the children about the role of the Air Ambulance team. We were able to get all 8 KS2 classes out to see the helicopter, before the medical team returned.

The children learned that it took the helicopter 13 minutes to get from Teesside to the school and that it can travel at 175 mph. Nigel also told us that it costs £3400 an hour to run the Air Ambulance.
