

Staffing

Absence

- Overall absence (9.7%) was in the **highest** 20% of all schools in 2021/22. It was also in the **highest** 20% of schools with a similar level of deprivation.
- Persistent absence (25.0%) was in the **highest** 20% of all schools in 2021/22. There is nothing to highlight for persistent absence compared to schools with a similar level of deprivation in 2021/22.

- For the whole school, there is nothing significant or exceptional to highlight for total suspensions compared to all schools in 2021/22, therefore no conclusions can be drawn from this data.
