## **REMOTE LEARNING PLAN**

Where an individual pupil or a small number of pupils are unable to attend school due to illness, the need to self-isolate, or if there is a local/ national lockdown requiring pupils to remain at home, Monkton Infants has the capacity to offer immediate remote education as outlined in this plan. Remote learning does not have to be purely digital.

## AIMS

- To provide a curriculum sequence that allows access to high quality online and offline resources, linked to the school's curriculum expectations
- To utilise online tools which can be used consistently across school in order to allow interaction, assessment and feedback
- To provide printed resources for pupils without suitable online access
- To ensure all pupils, including pupils with SEND, have equal access to remote education and high quality education resources
