# WELCOME BACK

### **OUTDOOR CLOTHING**

### STARTING AND LEAVING NURSERY

Start of Nursery session (8.30am and 12.40pm):

Nursery staff will come outside to the playground to meet the children and take them inside to hang up coats etc. Parents/carers will remain outside.

# End of Nursery session (11.30am and 3.40pm)

Children will be dismissed from the playground by Nursery staff. All children will be handed to parents/carers outside of Nursery.

### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

Please drive slowly and park safely on the nursery grounds.

<u>Do not</u> park on footpaths leading to the nursery entrance.

<u>Children</u> and <u>adults</u> <u>must not</u> ride Bicycles/Scooters on the nursery grounds.

Please hold your child's hand whilst on the nursery grounds. Children **must not** run around the car park or on the ramp leading up to the entrance.

Vaping/smoking **is not allowed** on the nursery grounds.

NO DOGS are allowed to walk / be carried onto the nursery site (apart from guide dogs) and <u>must not</u> be tied to the gates / railings.

The visitor toilet **is not** in use to parents or family members.



### HAIR & HYGIENE

Please could we remind you that all children with long hair must have their **hair tied up** in Nursery.

Although we have just begun a new school year, it is important to remember to regularly check your child's hair for head lice.

Head lice treatment is available free-of-charge from many local Pharmacies.

# **Important: Nursery Attendance Monitoring Procedures**

As you may know, pupil attendance is rigorously monitored within school and by the Local Authority's Attendance Monitoring Officer. However, as a result of recent Ofsted Inspections, we monitor pupil attendance and punctuality more stringently.

Poor attendance and punctuality have a negative impact on children's educational progress so it is important that we all work together to help raise attendance levels. Of course, we do understand that children do become poorly from time to time so if your child does become ill, please ensure they have the required time off school.

#### **Attendance**

- If your child is absent from Nursery, you must contact Mrs Ruffles via 'Class Dojo', at least 10 minutes before the start of the session.
- If no contact has been made for more than 3 days then nursery staff will contact home to find out the reason for the absence.
- Where no reason is provided within a 2 week period after returning to school; the absence will remain unauthorised.
- Attendance will be monitored by nursery staff and any concerns will be reported to the Headteacher for possible further action.
- If your child is absent due to a medical appointment, <u>evidence must be provided</u> otherwise the absence will remain unauthorised.
- If you are taking a Holiday (Leave of Absence) during term time, please see the Nursery staff for a Leave of Absence request form.

### **Punctuality**

- The nursery day starts at 8.30am for morning session and 12.40pm for afternoon session.
- Pupils should arrive at nursery before the start of their session to allow for a prompt start to the day.
- Poor punctuality will be monitored by nursery staff.
- Pupils who arrive at nursery 10 minutes after the start of the session will be marked as 'late during registration'.
