We are now seeking to recruit Independent Trust Members to join us.

The role of a Trust Member is extremely important, overseeing the achievement of the objectives of the Trust and aspects of its governance. Trust Members:

- oversee that the Trust fulfills its overall objectives
- take part in Annual and Extraordinary General Meetings
- appoint other Trust Members and also Members of the Board of Directors/Trustees and remove Members or Directors/Trustees should it become necessary to do so
- can amend the Trust's Articles of Association that determine the constitution and governance arrangements of the Trust.

The role of a Trust Member is one step removed from that of a Director/Trustee. While Trust Members have a 'hands off' role, they are crucial in maintaining an overview of the effectiveness of the trust structure and holding the Trustees to account.

You will be required to attend 2 meetings per year. The role is voluntary, all reasonable expenses in accordance with the Trustees and Governors Expenses Policy; including travel and childcare may be reimbursed.
