What is Beyond Words?

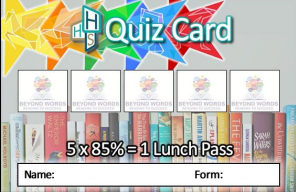
Beyond Words is our whole school reading programme that creates responsible, resilient and reflective readers.

It is geared towards helping students read and understand texts, not just in English but in every subject across the curriculum.

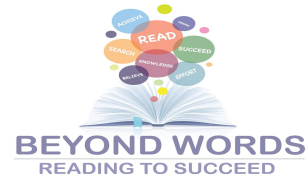

Show My Homework


- It is an easy to use, online homework calendar for schools.

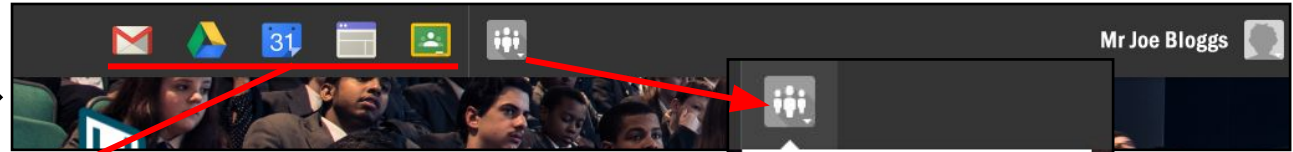
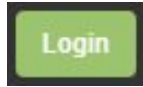

Google Classroom allows teachers to share assignments and other resources with students.

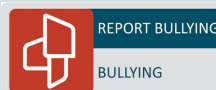

SEND at Heartlands High School

- 1. Information is passed on from primary school and shared with all teachers with regard to Key Stage 2 performance and a history of need.**
 - 2. We support our students in class with a large team of support staff, specialists and external professionals.**
 - 3. We ask parents to share with us any concerns that they might have regarding difficulties their children are having.**
 - 4. We have many small groups that are run during the day and after school to support catch up. This is similar to primary school.**
 - 5. Students are identified and are assessed by us and by professionals in Haringey.**
