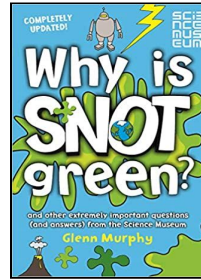
Title: *How do Engineers Reuse Rockets?*

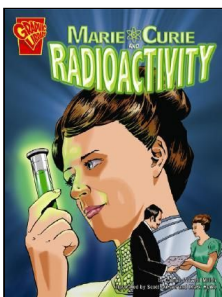
