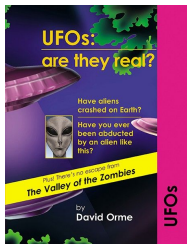

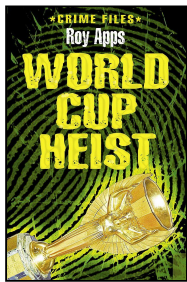
**Title:** *UFOs: are they real?*

Most people have opinions on UFOs and aliens. But are they real? Decide after reading this book. Plus, a zombie story!



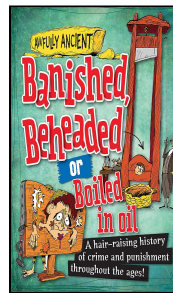
**Title:** *Blood Evidence*

Dive into forensics with this fact-filled book. Learn how bloodstain analysts use crime scene clues to track killers!



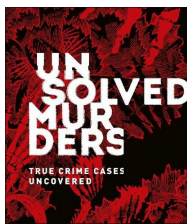
**Title:** *World Cup Heist*

Did you know that in 1966, a group of robbers planned to steal the Football World Cup? Read to learn their plan and whether they got away with it...



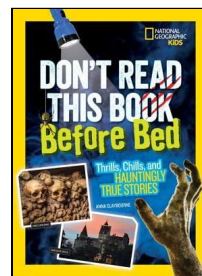

How did they punish criminals in Ancient Rome? What about in Medieval Europe? The answers might be too gruesome for some people, but they're all in this book.



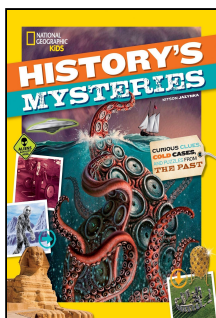

Read fact files on some of history's most notorious unsolved murders. Covers cases from the Zodiac Killer to JonBenét Ramsey.



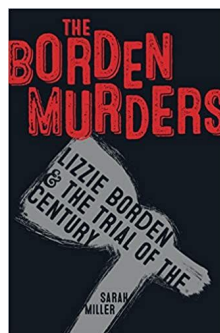

Thrills, chills, and hauntingly true stories: read about everything from zombies to haunted houses - that is, if you dare...



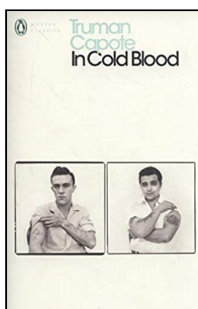

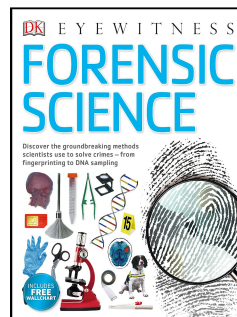
**Title:** *The Borden Murders*
