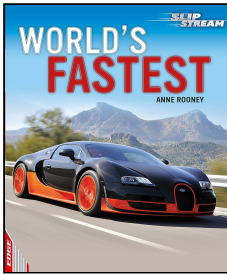


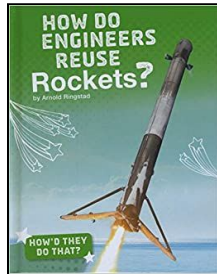

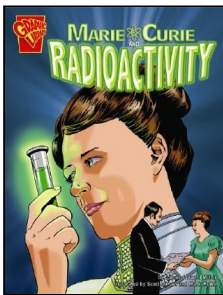
Title: *World's Fastest*

Rockets are huge and blast into space. So how do we gently rescue and reuse them?



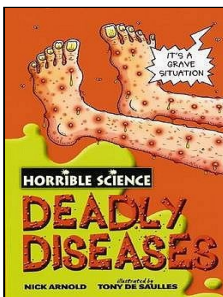
Title: *Mary Curie and Radioactivity*

Read the story of Marie Curie and discovery of radioactivity in graphic novel form.



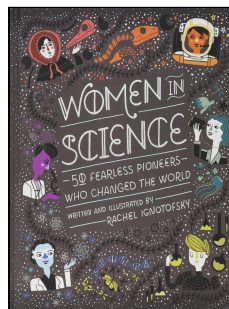
Title: *Stiff: the Curious Life of Human Cadavers*

What happens to the bodies of dead people? Often, they help scientists learn more about our world. Read all about how in this fascinating book!



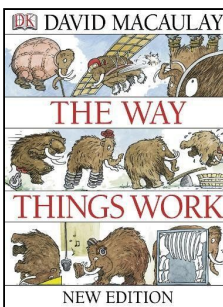
Title: *Deadly Diseases*

Finds out how your body tries to fight off germs, and what happens when it fails. For fans of *Horrible Histories*.



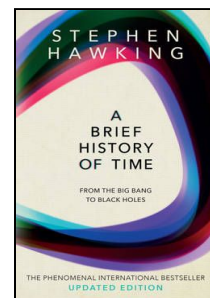
Title: *Women in Science: 50 Fearless Pioneers Who Changed the World!*

Women have long had to fight for equal rights. But that has never stopped them being amazing scientists!



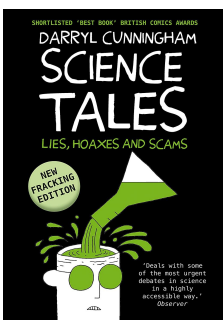
Title: *The Way Things Work*
