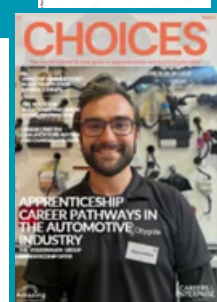

UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD - UNCOVER ENGINEERING: RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMME – FOR YEAR 10'S – CLOSING 31ST DEC

Uncover is a residential programme run by Oxford University that gives girls and Black African and Caribbean heritage students the opportunity to explore how maths and physics relate to Engineering, while offering a glimpse into university life. Students will stay in a college for 4 days. Days will be filled with engineering-focused activities and workshops organised by the Department of Engineering Science. In the evenings there will be recreational activities and social opportunities with other like-minded future engineers. They'll also find out about life at Oxford and living in a college.

There are two programmes

Uncover for Black African and Caribbean heritage Students - Students who identify as being of Black African and Caribbean heritage and students of mixed-race with Black African and Caribbean heritage, 30th March – 2nd April 2026 @ St Hugh's College and the Department of Engineering Science, University of Oxford

Uncover for Girls - For girls or students who identify as a girl or non-binary, 7th-10th April 2026 @ Trinity College and the Department of Engineering Science, University of Oxford

L3 Mortgages Apprentice – On this 1 year programme apprentices work towards a L3 Mortgage adviser apprenticeship. Apprentices will learn the foundations of mortgage broking through hands-on learning and structured apprenticeship training. They will learn how to support the Mortgage Administration team with case overflow and provide support with administrative tasks such as data entry, chasing and processing invoices and completion checks. They will also handle incoming enquiry phone calls and emails, play an active role in chasing solicitors via telephone calls and emails and work closely with brokers and support them with preparing mortgage documents

They will support the client service team with day-to-day administration, assist in obtaining terms from the insurance market and preparing client documentation and maintain accurate records and ensure timely processing of client requests.

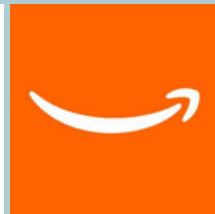
