The familiar after school routine often involves asking how your child's day was, only to receive the classic one word response of fine. MyChildAtSchool is your tool to break that cycle. Instead of guessing, you can use the app as a daily window into your child's world to spark meaningful conversations and build great organisational habits.

Before they walk through the door, take thirty seconds to check the timetable feature. This allows you to move past general questions and ask about their specific day focusing on the lessons you know they had! These specific questions show your child you are actively invested in their world, making them much more likely to open up.

The rewards dashboard tracks merits and positive points in real time, letting you praise them the same day.

Finally, the secret to a smooth morning is evening preparation. Use the app together the night before to check the next day's schedule. You can look at the timetable to ensure their PE kit is packed, check if they need specific textbooks or art supplies, and quickly review the homework tab to ensure nothing has slipped through the cracks.

Hopefully the app can help you to manage the busy after school schedule.

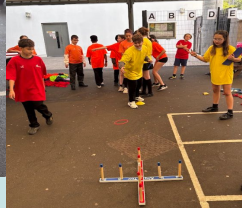
Safeguarding Spotlight:

We would like to inform parents and carers that the Free School Meals (FSM) application process is changing from September 2026. If your child currently receives Free School Meals, their eligibility will **not** automatically continue into the new academic year. All families who wish to be considered for Free School Meals from September 2026 must submit a new application.

Application forms will be sent to parents by email by the end of this week. Hard copies will also be available from the school reception for anyone who prefers to complete a paper form.

We strongly encourage parents to submit their applications as soon as possible to ensure that eligibility can be checked and support can be put in place without delay.

You will receive a copy of your child's AFA2 report by post in the last week of term. You will also be able to see your child's results on the DPR when they go live. You will receive a text message informing you of this.
