The term began with the publication of our Ofsted report. The report graded our school to be **Good with Outstanding Leadership and Management** because "Leaders have a thorough and accurate understanding of the school, driving improvements rapidly where they identify the need for improvement". The school leaders "are uncompromising in their ambition for pupils' outcomes and have shaped a culture within the school of high expectation and aspiration".

Another set of tremendous A Level results

Alperton Community School students have again exceeded all expectations with a tremendous set of A Level results. ACS students have been awarded 48 A* and A grades, with almost half of the examinations being awarded A*, A or B grades. As a result more than a third of the A level cohort has been accepted onto degree courses at prestigious Russell Group universities.

We are moving from texting parents to communicating via our new free app for smartphones. Our app will give you access to lots of information about the school and your child at school.


The app is available for Android or Apple smartphones and enables us to send you information about your child in the most efficient manner. Any letters we send will go directly to your phone and you will receive a notification message.
