

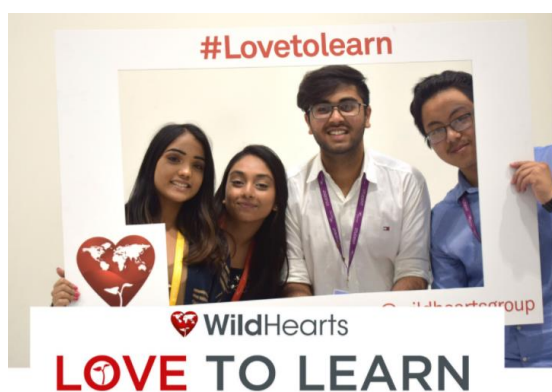
## Extra-Curricular activities and testimonials undertaken by ACS students 2016/17 ACS
