BBC Young Reporter



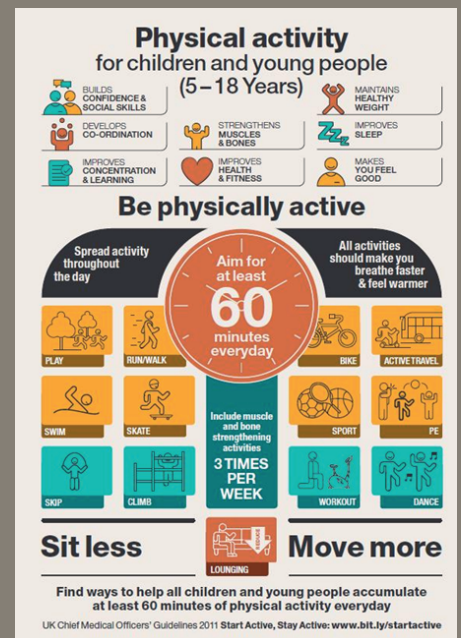
