All students have begun attending the compulsory Alperton Community School **Transition Programme** which began on the **28th April 2020** via our online teaching platforms. Students must join this compulsory programme using the following **Google Classroom Code: f2ycbuc**

Please be advised that all our Level 3 courses require students to achieve Grade 4 or above in their Maths, English and Science GCSEs alongside any subject specific entry criteria which are listed on our website.

If your son/daughter wishes to apply to a college he/she should use this time to research the course they wish to pursue, which can be done virtually using the Unifrog tool. Students can visit the college websites to gain more information about the colleges and their entry requirements.

In line with our safeguarding policy students will be expected to hand in their **School ID cards and lanyards** when the school re-opens, we will be in touch with more details about this when appropriate.
