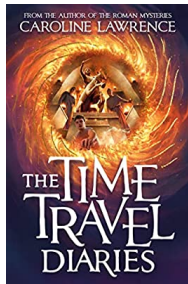


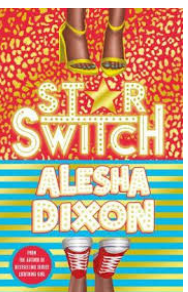
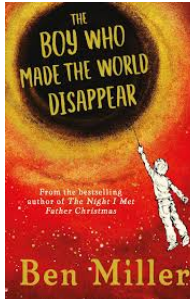
June is LGBTQ+ Pride Month!
