

Year 9 History

What will be studied?

Topic(s)

Terms 1, 2 and 3

Students begin their GCSE course by studying Anglo-Saxon England. Beginning with Anglo-Saxon society students will investigate how society operated in 1060. They will then study the impact of Edward the Confessors death and how William the Conqueror came to become king. Students will then go on to study how William I established control and all the challenges he faced. Finally they will evaluate Norman England and all the changes that were made by William I up until his death.

Students are assessed through GCSE style exam papers throughout the year alongside deeper investigative projects.
