Year 8 – Textiles

What will be studied?

Topic(s)

The focus of the 6 week project is to introduce students to a wide range of textile techniques such as Batik and tie-dye and teaching them to use a sewing machine. This helps prepare students for KS4 by working on the EDUCAS GCSE assessment objective (AO2): experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques, processes.

Alongside the practical elements of the project, students begin to develop begin to explore a wide variety of Textile artists linking to the theme of cultural identity to build on students cultural capital. This is in line with the EDUCAS assessment objectives AO1: Understanding critical sources. Students complete a final outcome over an extended period of time preparing students for GCSE when they will be expected to produce a final outcome within a time frame.
