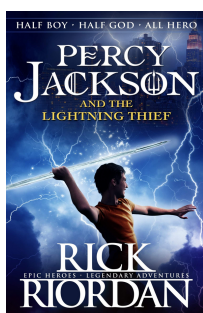


Series Spotlight: Pages & Co
