New BookTrust books coming soon!




This month, we received 50 free books from the literacy charity Book Trust - keep your eyes out for these three and more, which will be out in the library very soon!



Author Spotlight: Humza Arshad




Before he began writing books, Humza Arshad was a Youtuber making the *Diary of a Badman* series. After achieving 90 million views, he had his own scripted comedy series on BBC3, and since 2015 has visited 120 schools, using comedy to prevent at-risk students becoming radicalised. He decided to write the *Little Badman* books after imagining what a the character from his Youtube series would have got up to when he was younger. The first two books in the series - *The Invasion of the Killer Aunties*, and *The Time-Travelling Teacher of Doom* are available to borrow from the library now!
