Students follow their current timetable. ● Pastoral Manager checks access to a digital device and internet. Resources provided if there is an issue. ● Wherever possible, teachers share classroom lessons using Google Meet. ● Teachers provide learning on Google Classroom. ● Teachers set homework on SMHW in the usual way.
A whole class/ bubble are self- isolating but other classes are in school	<p>Actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Teachers are provided with a list of self-isolating classes and students in the bulletin each day. ● Self-isolating classes follow the normal timetable. ● In-school classes follow the normal timetable. ● Wherever possible, teachers deliver lessons to the self-isolating class using Google Meet ● If teachers are unable to deliver a lesson using Google Meet, teachers will set work will be set on Google Classroom. ● Pastoral Manager checks access to a digital device and internet. Resources provided if there is an issue. ● Teachers set homework on SMHW in the usual way.
