This autumn term Alperton Community School have partnered up with the National Citizen Service (NCS) to give our Year 12 students an exciting and exclusive opportunity to take part in the NCS programme for free.

NCS will be running 6 days' worth of outdoor activities and workshops, all specially designed to help boost your young person's confidence, take them out of their comfort zone and give them skills to support their personal and professional development.

The programme will run from the 4th - 6th October and 11th - 13th October.

During the first three days of the programme, we will be taking the students off the school site where they will take part in outdoor activities. On day one they will be visiting Go Ape at Alexandra Palace. On day two they will be taking part in Delta Force Paintballing, and for their final day they will learn some exciting bush craft skills with London Bushcraft! Please find the full programme timetable attached.

As NCS will be taking the students off school site, they will require medical forms to be filled in by parents/guardians before the young person can attend the activities. A link will be sent to your email address which will take you to an online form. If the medical form is not filled in, your young person will not be able to take part in the programme.

Please ensure that this medical form is completed as soon as possible, the deadline for these to be completed is the **28th September**. This is so that they can be processed and any medical follow up calls can be made before they start on the 4th October.
