

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Healthy school food has obvious health benefits and can help pupils establish healthy habits for life. Healthy school food can also help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual household net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Children who receive a qualifying benefit in their own right are also allowed to receive free school meals. Children under the compulsory school age who are in full time education may also be entitled to receive free school meals.

Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,345 for your child's primary school and £955 for your child's secondary school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities. This additional money, known as Pupil Premium, is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above.

If you receive benefits **please apply using this form** to ensure that your child's school receives this important extra funding – even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal.

You must complete all sections of the application form, including all details of each child attending a school in Brent and sign the declaration statement. We may contact you if any more information is required.

**Please note:** For children in schools not in Brent you will have to apply to the borough that maintains the school. Eligibility for free school meals will not be backdated.

The information shall be retained for six years after the end of your child's education and shall be processed in adherence to your legal rights, including but not limited to the right to withdraw consent, right to copies of your information and right to be forgotten.
