There is NO coursework

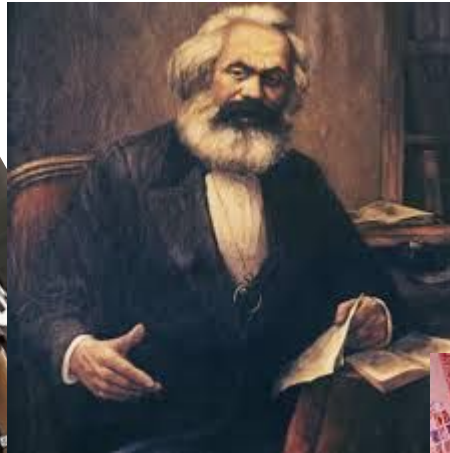
