Year 9 Options | Welcome

GCSE RS is an interesting dive into the relevance of religious belief in the Twenty First century. You will study the key beliefs of two great religious traditions and how beliefs impact on key issues facing society today.

Year 9 Options | Course content

Across Year 10 and 11 you will study the beliefs and teachings of Islam and Chrstianity, using sacred texts and religious authorities toevidence your learning. You will also study four key themes which further deepen and develop the learning you have been doing in Year 9. These are taught using beliefs from all religious traditions.

These themes are: Religion and Human Relationships (marriage, family, sexuality). Life (origins of the universe, origins of life, animal rights, abortion and euthanasia), Peace and Conflict (war, terrorism, protest, peacekeeping) and finally Crime and Punishment(Reasons for Crime, Types and reasons for punishments, the Death Penalty)

There is no coursework.




Year 9 Options | Other info ...
