<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be <b>READY, RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE</b> and <b>RESILIENT</b> at all times.</li> <li>• Complete work, including homework, to the best of my ability and make sure any work missed due to absence is up to date.</li> <li>• Arrive punctually no later than 8:20am for the start of the school day.</li> <li>• Wear my school uniform with pride to school, throughout the school day and on the way home from school.</li> <li>• Be prepared with the correct equipment e.g. pens, pencils, ACS PE kit etc.</li> <li>• Care for the environment including all the school's resources. I understand that if I damage any school property, that my parents/ carers will be expected to pay for the damage.</li> <li>• Always move around the school building in a calm and sensible manner.</li> <li>• Always keep to school zones allocated to my year group including entrances, playgrounds, canteen, stairs and toilets.</li> <li>• Eat healthy food in school, on the way to school and going home from school.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be courteous and polite whenever communicating with school staff.</li> <li>• Inform the school immediately of any changes to your contact details including address and phone numbers.</li> <li>• Ensure that your child attends school on time, in the correct uniform and that they are properly equipped for all lessons including PE.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to work hard and support them by discussing their school work and homework with them every day.</li> <li>• Set the highest possible standards for attendance and ensure that holidays are only taken in the allocated holiday weeks as indicated on the school calendar. Ensure that you telephone the attendance officer immediately if your child is unwell and unable to attend school.</li> <li>• Attend all parent evenings and take a full part in discussions about your child's well-being and progress.</li> <li>• Support the school's healthy eating policy by either providing healthy packed lunches or ensuring that your child uses the school's cashless dining facilities; by not giving your child money to buy food on the way home from school.</li> <li>• Do not allow your child to bring a smartphone to school. Students are expected to bring a basic phone to school without internet access.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Develop students who are <b>READY, RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE</b> and <b>RESILIENT</b> so that they are ready to make a positive contribution to society locally, nationally and internationally.</li> <li>• Ensure the safety and welfare of all our students.</li> <li>• Provide a broad, balanced and rich curriculum.</li> <li>• Make lessons relevant, interesting and accessible to all of our students.</li> <li>• Celebrate the successes of our students regularly and use sanctions as a last resort.</li> <li>• Regularly assess the standards your child has reached and celebrate the progress made by your child. Give students the opportunity to improve their work after assessments.</li> <li>• Keep parents/ carers informed about the standard attained and progress made by their child on a regular basis.</li> <li>• Treat everyone in our school community with respect and to have high expectations for all our students regardless of their starting point.</li> <li>• Use every opportunity to intervene where students need to catch up so that no child is left behind.</li> </ul>

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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep my mobile phone at home or switched-off in my school bag.</li> <li>• Adhere to the ACS ICT E-safe and acceptable use policy.</li> <li>• Maintain the highest standards of behaviour in public (on the way to school, on the way home from school, using public transport or during school trips)</li> <li>• Make my way home by the quickest route without loitering or stopping in any of the local shops.</li> <li>• Inform the DSL, a HoY, PM or a member of staff if I am concerned about the welfare or well-being of another student, or if I am concerned something may happen to them.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Alert the school immediately if there are any special circumstances that may affect your child's learning.</li> <li>• Work in partnership with the school to promote the highest standards of behaviour for your child.</li> <li>• Agree to your child's photograph or film/ video footage to be taken which will be used internally to celebrate progress and achievement in the school and externally to promote the success of the school to prospective parents/ carers.</li> <li>• Allow your child to attend off-site school visits.</li> <li>• Agree to the biometric policy.</li> <li>• Agree for and encourage your child to fully take part in the school's PSHE curriculum and extra-curricular activities.</li> <li>• Agree for your child to attend intervention sessions that may take place after school/ during the school holidays.
