What will be studied?

Topic(s)

Term 1:

World War One - During this term students will investigate the causes, events and consequences of WWI. Students will focus on the conflict disrupting the balance of power and the inter-relationship of long-term and short-term causes.

Term 2:

Interwar years and World War Two - this leads onto students studying the role played by the Treaty of Versailles in causing the Second World War and developing their knowledge on the causes, consequences and events of WWII.

Term 3:

London during WWII and Challenges for Britain and the wider world - Students will study the challenges British democracy faced from the Nazi regime. They will study local history and the impact of bombings on society. They will then go onto study an eclectic course of various global events and how this has shaped the modern world; for example the US Civil Rights.

Students are assessed through GCSE style exam papers throughout the year alongside deeper investigative projects.
