

FAQs: Sixth Form Bursary Scheme

Question: What is it?

 This is funding provided by the Government for 16-19 year olds who would benefit from financial support while they are in further education.

Question: How many types of Bursaries are there?

• There are four levels of Bursary that qualify you to receive different amounts and you are allocated the most suitable one by the Inclusion Lead at 6th Form.

Question: How will the school know which Level I qualify for?

 All applicants must provide evidence of the total household income and all other necessary financial information requested.

Question: Are there any conditions attached to this Bursary?

 Students must meet the conditions covered by the 6th Form student contract. The allocated amount will also be adjusted dependent on percentage attendance and needs.

Question: What should I be spending the funding on?

 Students commonly spend their funding on lunch, stationary, books required for their subjects, UCAS applications, travel, University visits and Interviews, Trips required as part of their A Level.

Question: What do I need to apply?

- Complete the online application form
- Evidence for the Level of Bursary you are applying for
