

## FAQs: Sixth Form Bursary Scheme

### Question: What is it?

- This is funding provided by the Government for 16-19 year olds who would benefit from financial support while they are in further education.

### Question: How many types of Bursaries are there?

- There are four levels of Bursary that qualify you to receive different amounts and you are allocated the most suitable one by the Inclusion Lead at 6th Form.

### Question: How will the school know which Level I qualify for?

- All applicants must provide evidence of the total household income and all other necessary financial information requested.

### Question: Are there any conditions attached to this Bursary?

- Students must meet the conditions covered by the 6th Form student contract. The allocated amount will also be adjusted dependent on percentage attendance and needs.

### Question: What should I be spending the funding on?

- Students commonly spend their funding on lunch, stationary, books required for their subjects, UCAS applications, travel, University visits and Interviews, Trips required as part of their A Level.

- Complete the online application form
