Behaviour for Learning Update

Pupils at Alperton Community School have a long track record of behaving well both in and out of lessons. You will no doubt appreciate that good behaviour is a key feature of any successful school. With this in mind, at ACS we regularly review our behaviour procedures and policies, making changes where necessary.

Our latest review has resulted in changes to our behaviour policy in relation to missed detentions and in the accumulation of a significant number of negative points.

I have attached a [presentation](#) that will be shared with your child during form time and assemblies in the upcoming weeks. Please spend a little time reading this document so that you are fully aware of these changes.

Key changes are:

- Students who are late to school have a 20 minute breaktime detention on the day they are late.
- Failure to attend late detentions could result in parent meetings with the SLT link during SLT Surgery on Fridays after school.
- Introduction of Saturday Headteacher's detention where students will be expected to attend school on a Saturday in full school uniform and meet with the Headteacher.

We ask that all parents download the MCAS app. If you are having any log in problems then please contact your child's pastoral manager. Remember that you and your child now receive all notifications regarding behaviour, including detentions, via MCAS emails and app notifications.. Your support is valued. We will continue to ensure all students are ready, respectful, responsible and resilient and ready to seize the opportunities available to them in the future.
