A LEVEL RESULTS 2023

- Average grade has increased by one grade since 2019
- 44% of our students achieved A*-B in every subject
 - 70% of the grades achieved were A* B
- 97% of our vocational students achieved Distinction*, Distinction or Merit grades
- 83% of our students achieved At/Above their expected target grades
- 146 A* and A grades
- 47 Distinction* (star) Distinction grades
- 240 A* B grades or equivalent
 - Over 40% of students achieved an A* A grade in Textiles, Maths, Further Maths, Sociology, Geography and Chemistry
- 75% or more students achieved a Distinction* Distinction in ICT, Health & Social Care and Business Finance courses.
