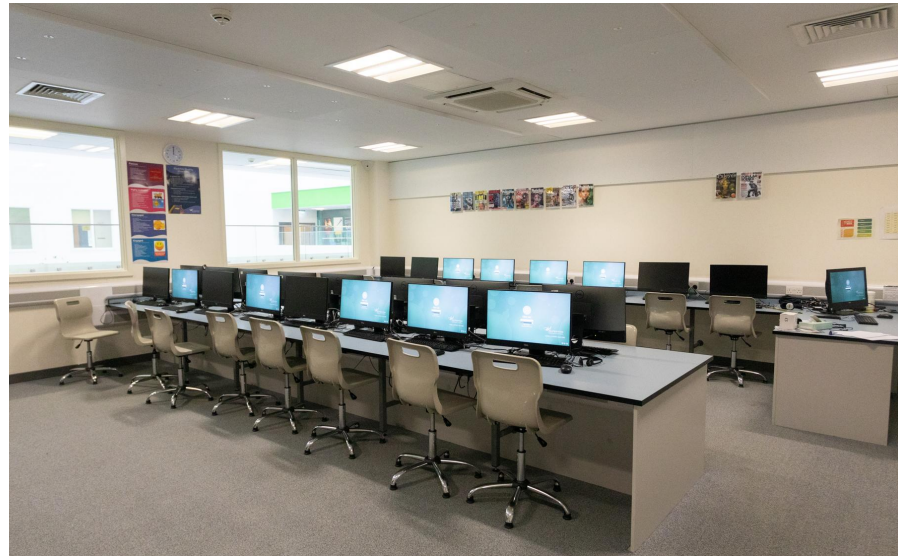

**Entry requirements**  
Minimum BB grades at GCSE in Core and Additional Science or BBB in Triple Science.  
Required grades: B grade in GCSE Maths and B grade in GCSE English Language.

**What will I learn?**  
At AS Level you will learn the detailed structure of atoms, how chemicals join together (bonding), chemical patterns (periodicity) and organic chemistry (carbon chemistry) and how to use chemical calculations. After Christmas you learn about energy, rates of reactions, equilibria, reduction and oxidation, group II metals, the Halogens and analytical techniques.

**How will I be assessed?**  
You will sit two written papers during AS Chemistry  
The remaining marks are achieved through a practical ISA examination.

**Where will this course lead to?**  
What can I do with it?  
Chemistry is a key A Level for many careers including Optometry, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacy Pharmacology, Engineering, Veterinary Science, Medicine, Physiotherapy, Radiography and, of course, Chemistry, Industrial Chemistry and Chemical Engineering!

# A LEVEL RESULTS 2023

Our A Level results were significantly better than those reported nationally

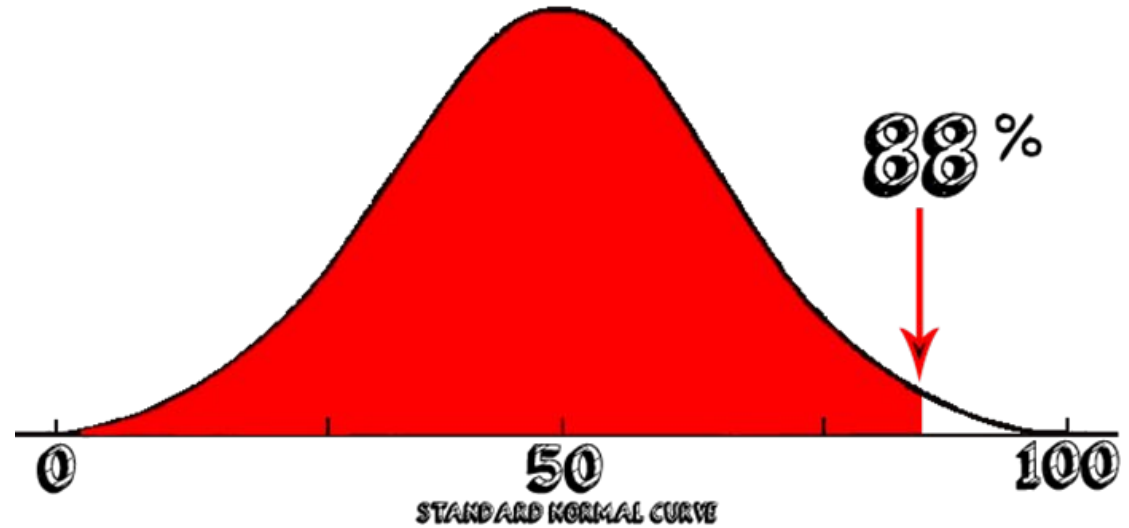
- A\* - A 4% better than national
- A\* - B 9% better than national
- A\* - E 3% better than national

# A LEVEL RESULTS 2023

- Average grade has increased by one grade since 2019
- **44%** of our students achieved A\*-B in every subject
- **70%** of the grades achieved were A\* - B
- **97%** of our vocational students achieved Distinction\*, Distinction or Merit grades
- **83%** of our students achieved At/Above their expected target grades
  
- **146** A\* and A grades
- **47** Distinction\* (star) - Distinction grades
- **240** A\* - B grades or equivalent
  
- **Over 40%** of students achieved an A\* - A grade in Textiles, Maths, Further Maths, Sociology, Geography and Chemistry
- **75% or more** students achieved a Distinction\* - Distinction in ICT, Health & Social Care and Business Finance courses.
