Year 9 Options | Welcome

The **Creative iMedia** course provides you with the opportunity to continue building your graphic design skills from year 9 and learn theoretical skills in photography, filming and editing. You can choose the subject even if you didn't do it in year 9.

Think about how much media you consume. Wouldn't it be exciting to be able to create media products yourself and share it with others?

They types of students who typically do well on the course have the desire to **develop** the following skills:

- Creativity
- Analysis
- Use of Adobe Creative Cloud (including Photoshop and Illustrator)
- Critical reflection
- Time management & organisation



Year 9 Options | Assessment

How will you be assessed?

- The course is divided into **3 units**
 - 2 coursework units (total = 60%)
 - 1 exam (40%)

You will be **assessed evenly** over the two years with one coursework unit submitted in year 10 and one in year 11.

This helps to ease the pressure towards the end of year 11 when you will have all of your exams.


Year 9 Options | Additional info

- You can write for <u>BBC Young Reporter</u>






