## Monday 10 February 2025, Non Uniform Day

We will be having an optional non uniform day on Monday 10 February 2025.

This is a great opportunity for the school community to raise funds for future trips that they will have the opportunity to take part in. For example, we currently have two sixth form groups preparing to go to Tanzania and Cambodia to volunteer in primary schools and an elephant sanctuary. Part of the funds raised will contribute to the costs of this trip, and the school will allocate the rest of the funds to trips as they are planned throughout the academic year.

Students will have the option to not take part and wear full school uniform or wear non uniform and contribute a minimum of £2 in cash or via Parent Pay. A register on the day will be taken to ensure that all students who arrive in non uniform are contributing to the trip fund.

Please note, that all students are welcome to participate and we encourage any student or family experiencing financial hardship and are unable to contribute £2 to email or speak to their year group Pastoral Managers.

While embracing the community spirit of fundraising, we do need to remind students of some items that will not be allowed on site during the non uniform day. Students are encouraged to wear 'modest business attire' suitable for a learning environment. Items not permitted are listed below:

- No strap tops (bare shoulders)
- No bare midriffs (crop tops)
- No political or offensive logos
- No skirts/dresses above the knee
- No high heels or open toed shoes
- No hats/caps
- No balaclavas/bandanas

Please encourage students to follow these rules to ensure that all students can have a pleasant day, wearing clothing they have selected for the day. Lessons will, of course, continue as normal, and students should bring their usual school books and equipment, including their normal PE kit if they have a Sport and Health lesson on Monday.
