Pre Public Exams (PPE2)

After half term students in Year 11 and Year 13 will sit a second set of Pre Public Exams (PPE2). This is an extremely important opportunity for your child to demonstrate improvements in knowledge and exam skills since PPE1 and to practise exam questions under timed conditions in the formal exam venues they will be using in the summer.

We expect your child to use the following weeks for focussed revision following the subject specific revision plans which have been shared through the VIP Zone. To further support students' preparations for PPE2, a number of targeted interventions are taking place in school during half term. If your child is expected to attend a session, you will receive a message from Ms Dieny (Year 11) or Ms Kaniude (Year 13) with full details.
