Course Details: Who is this Course for?

This course is for students progressing from GCSE into Level 3 (A Level or Equivalent) studies, with a view to study this subject or related subjects at degree level.

Course Details: What Will You Learn?

Year 1	Students learn a widening range of art methods, styles and approaches in Digital Photography, which prepares them for Year 2. The work produced is internally assessed and students can choose which work they take onto their Year 2 portfolio.
Year 2	Personal Investigation Unit 1: There are two major elements: supporting (written 1000 words) studies and practical work (photographing people, photographing places, still-life photography, documentary photography, experimental imagery, fashion photography, digital imaging). Students produce a portfolio of development work and outcomes based on themes and ideas developed from researching primary and contextual sources, recording observations, experimenting with media and processes, and refining ideas to produce personal resolved outcome(s). A2 Course: ESA Unit 2: There are two major elements: supporting (written) studies and practical work (photographic installation, moving image (video, film, animation), lens-free photography, digital experimentation). Students produce a portfolio of development work and outcomes based on themes and ideas developed from researching primary and contextual sources, recording observations, experimenting with media and processes, and refining ideas to produce personal resolved outcome(s) in response to an externally set theme.
