Year 9 are currently in the process of gaining information, advice and guidance about the options they will be choosing to study in Year 10. As part of this, we are excited to invite you to our dedicated Year 9 **Options Event on Monday 16 March, at Ealing Road**, where you can come along with your child to discuss subjects and ask questions. Please note this is a revised date due to the celebration of Eid for many in our community.

This is a really valuable opportunity for students and their families to talk to subject teachers, look at what careers the subject can offer and see work completed in the subject.

Parents, carers and students in **9K, 9L, 9N, 9P, 9Q and 9R** are invited to attend the first session (**4PM - 5PM**), and parents, carers and students in **9S, 9T, 9V, 9W, 9X and 9Y** are invited to attend the second session (**5:30 PM - 6:30 PM**). A register will be taken on entry for health and safety purposes.

Please do ensure your child is dressed in **full school uniform** and arrives with you at the beginning of the allocated time slot. Entry will not be permitted if full school uniform is not worn and/or arrival is not at the beginning of the allocated time slot.

On Tuesday 17 March, the Options Form will be live and available via the [Student Portal](#). Students should already be familiar with this. As outlined in the [Year 9 Options Booklet - Make an Informed Choice](#), choices are primarily awarded on a first come first served basis, so it is vital that students are able to access the portal. You will be able to view the choices on [MCAS](#), but will not be able to make any changes.
