Course Details: Who is this Course for?

English Literature A Level is an exciting, challenging and immensely rewarding course. You will engage with genre and theory including unseen texts which require wide-reaching general knowledge of literary periods and social and political history. If you are up for the challenge, you will no doubt excel in A Level English Literature.

Course Details: What Will You Learn?

Year 1 and Year 2	Paper 1: Literary Genres - Aspects of Tragedy: The study of Aspects of Tragedy in three texts, which include Othello, Death of a Salesman and Keats' poetry. The examination will be closed book. Paper 2: Texts and Genres - Elements of Political and Social Protests: The study of Elements of social and political protest writing in three texts, Blake's Songs of Innocence and Experience, Hosseini's The Kite Runner and Atwood's The Handmaid's Tale. The examination will be open book. NEA (Non-Exam Assessment): Two essays between 1200-1500 words each responding to a different text of your choice, linking to a different aspect of the Critical anthology. One text must be prose and the other must be poetry.
