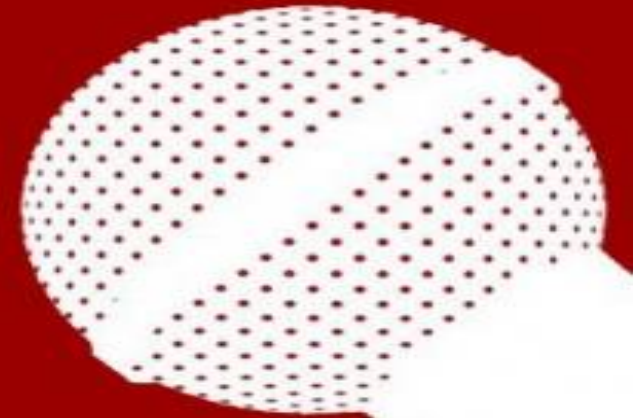

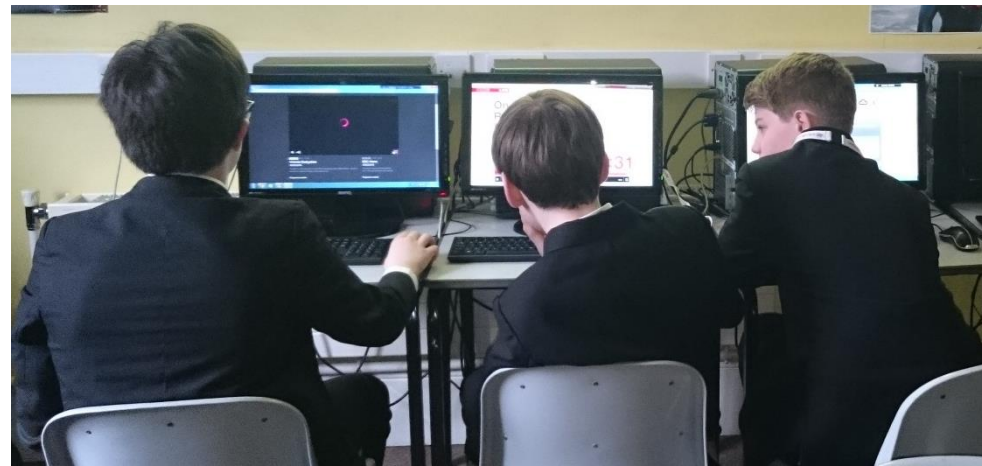

James made a few last minute changes to make it as slick as possible.



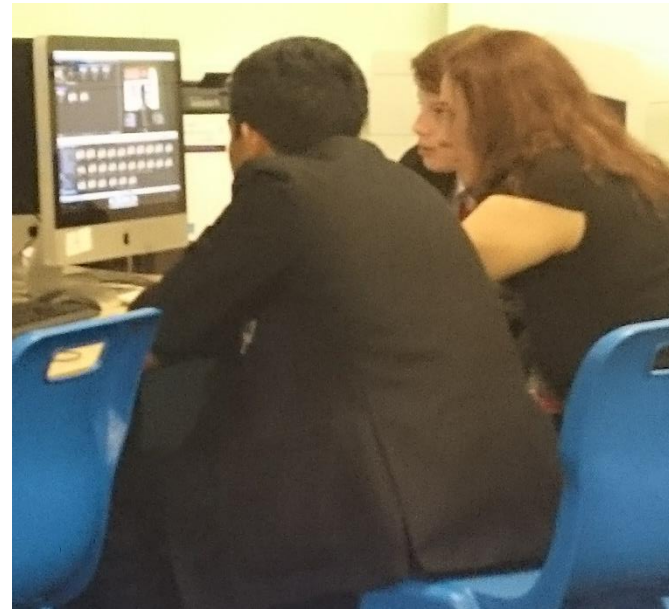
